## Gas: gas bill significantly down (34.2%) for consumption in January 2023

ARERA communicates the value of the commodity: 68.37 €/MWh, January wholesale list prices down significantly compared to December

Milan, 2 February 2023 - Gas bill drops for households still under protection regimes. Based on the average trend of the Italian wholesale market in January 2023 and for consumption in the same month, for the typical household<sup>1</sup> in protection regime, a decrease is recorded of -34.2% in the bill compared to December 2022.

The gas price component covering procurement costs (CMEMm), applied to customers still under protection, is updated by ARERA as a monthly average of the price on the Italian wholesale market (the PSV day ahead) and published within the first 2 working days of the month following the reference month.

For the month of January, which recorded a significantly lower average wholesale price than that of December, the price of the commodity gas (CMEMm), for customers with protection contracts, was 68.37 €/MWh\*.

The reduction for the month of January, in terms of final effects, still does not fully compensate for the high price levels reached in the last year, with **gas expenditure for the typical household** in the rolling year (February 2022-January 2023) amounting to approximately **1,769 euros**, +**36% compared to the equivalent 12 months of the previous year (February 2021-January 2022)**.

Please note that, as provided for in the 'Budget Law', for the first quarter of 2023 ARERA has already zeroed the *general system charges* also for gas. Also confirmed is the negative UG2 component for gas consumption up to 5,000 scm/year and the 5% VAT reduction on gas.
